- If a school misses AYP two years in a row, but has made AYP for > 80% of subgroups, AND has a grade of A+ from A to C, the school itself decides remediation.
 - "Intervention" schools (NCLB) can avoid closure by getting a C (A+) and meeting AYP in one more subgroup each in math and reading.
