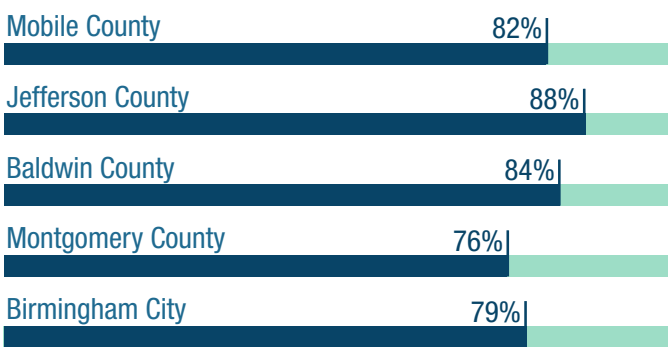
# Alabama's Largest School Districts

## Percent of Graduating Cohort Within the State

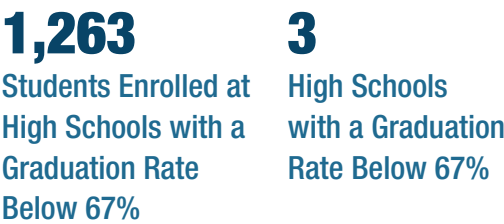

## Percent of Graduating Cohort Within the State

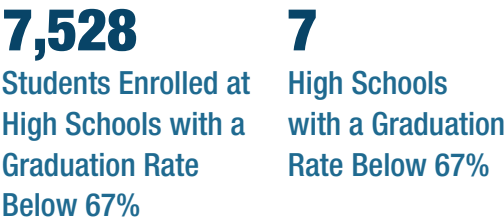

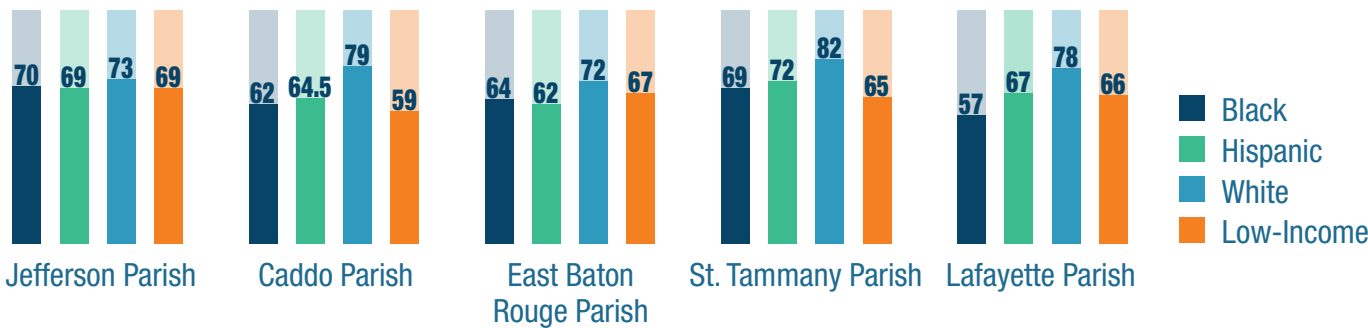

## Percent of Graduating Cohort Within the State

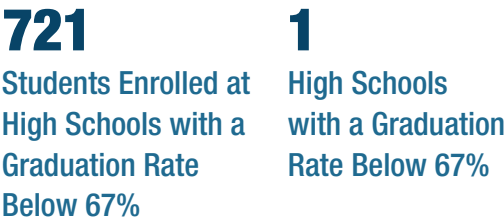

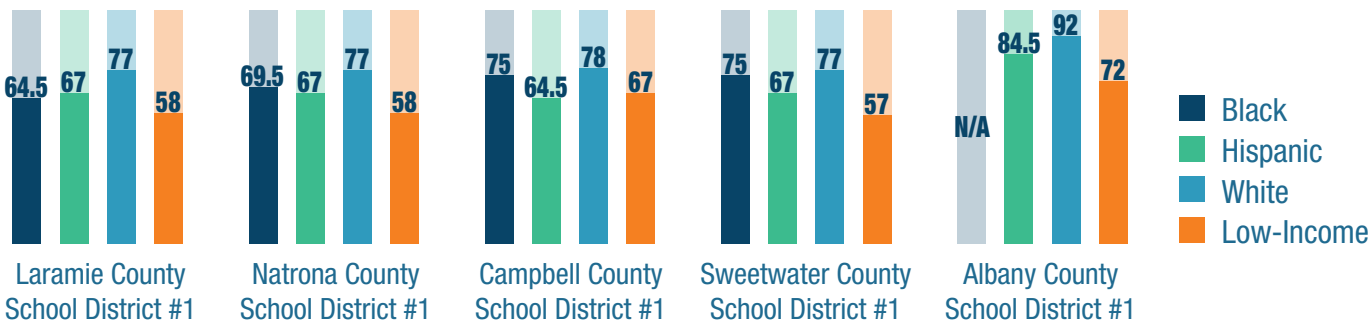
